As a woman who has a family to take care of but you are always on the road and sometimes work late in the office. What gives you the strength and if I may ask, how has the work load not affected the home front?

Thank you very much. This is a question that I

always receive especially when I'm addressing a gathering of women and the reason for the question is not far- fetched because I'm a woman, nobody will ever ask a man if his job is not affecting his home. This is because a woman is expected to maintain the home front as a wife, as a mother and as a role model. So much is expected from a woman and personally I'm someone who is always focused, I'm a goal getter. I don't get distracted at all. You may say I'm in my own world. However I set my priorities, I'm a person of process and structure. I like to structure things around me, I'm a very organized person when it comes to my activities. I don't like it when I don't know what to do in the next 10 minutes. So every day of my life, I know what I want to do and know how to do it. I think ahead as a deep thinker because you have to be strategic in your thinking. This office has exposed me to a lot of things. I've met different people even as a broadcast journalist, I've worked with and met different people including VIPs in the course of my profession. So coming into politics, the experience from the establishments where I have worked has actually helped and still helping me. Striking a balance between my work and the home front is all thanks to the husband I have because from the outset, we both agreed that I am doing politics together. He is not into politics but I'm in to it but based on the agreement that we both had, he's a man who has shown understanding. Because I'm a focused person and I always organized myself and put structures around me to help me function well, I don't have any clash of interest between my work load and the home front. I'm a family woman who keeps the home front going. In fact in my daughter's school, when I made calls to her teacher or the HM and I asked specific questions, he would ask me how I placed attention to those things because of my very busy schedules because other parents don't even ask the kind of questions that I asked. I manage my time very well. That is why I have different times for different activities.

Now that you have confessed to be a politician, what is your political ambition after this office?

The only ambition if I'm allowed to say it as the DG Community Communications is BAO 2026. Give me BAO 2026, I'm okay. Because when you have a leader like Governor BAO in Nigeria (as confirmed by the Vice President) in other states in Nigeria, things will be better. If you have someone like this Governor, the best thing to do is to throw all your support for that man and that is all I'm doing and continue to do here. He's a man who is not emotional or sentimental about his decision and policies, a man who is very calm and firm. He knows how to do something right at every given time even if its going to hurt him.

So we cannot be fighting over car. We cannot ask his Excellency to buy cars for us when the people in town are asking for palliatives. It will not be right if

Kabiyesis are fighting over cars. We understand that it is not his fault even though we are still expectant, there are a lot of things we want His Excellency to do for us for instance, there has been no improvement in the stipends and allowances of the Obas since Ekiti State was created until BAO's arrival.

That reminds me that some traditional rulers in Ekiti confided in me that the issue of

changing their cars was long overdue as a state policy which has not been implemented by previous administrations and that the last one was done many years ago...

Cuts in. Yes precisely 2013. I am the Chairman of the Council and I am on the Governor's side and I know he's facing so many problems now. If he has the money, why not?, But I cannot confidently ask him to buy the cars for us now because I know the economic situation in the country. Even people on the street will not be happy if they hear that His Excellency is spending 3 to 4 billion naira to buy cars for Kabiyesis. People will stone us. So I cannot confidently ask him to buy cars for us but I know if he has money and the money is surplus I know he would do the right thing because I know BAO is a very decent person who understands Ekiti.

He knows us individually. He knows that some Kabiyesis' cars are not good. The cars that were bought 11 years ago cannot fare better. Many of the engines have knocked. Many of Kabiyesis are spending their money on repairs which is not good enough. But one thing I know is that if BAO has the money he would definitely do the needful so, I don't need to put any pressure on

In the past two years what would you say have changed in Ekiti since the assumption of office of Governor BAO?

The atmosphere has changed. Anybody that enters Ekiti now will know that we have peace.

> The workers are happy. Government is paying salaries on time. They are paying our palace staffs regularly. We traditional rulers get paid every month. Before he came, we were owed three months by the previous administration. But when he came in, he paid the backlog and he has not failed to pay our stipends every month. We are asking for more even where we have inequalities. We know he's very intelligent because he understands

Ekiti. He is somebody you don't need to preach to because even before you ask, he has done it. I believe that with BAO in the saddle, things will continue to improve. That is why most of us are of the opinion that the next six years, he would be there. He would have stabilized and it would be difficult for anybody who comes to reverse our gains. That is why all of us are behind him including my humble self.








Governor BAO's Agric Revolution Is On Course.




nder the leadership of Governor Biodun Abayomi Oyebanji, we started the agricultural revolution program about two years ago. When we came in, we had meetings with different stakeholders; farmers, agro-traders, the cooperatives and the youths amongst others to be able to understand what are the issues that they have. They told us a lot of things and we came up with 6 agenda that eventually became the items that we are

following in the Ministry of Agric and Food Security. I will mention them one after the other. First one is Agricultural Productivity Improvement. Our farmers complained that our yield per hectare is one of the lowest compared with national average. So we came up with the root causes of the problem like the types of seeds they are using, tractors and even the land preparation as. We looked at these issues and came



EKSU and BOUESTI all of which are presently having our cluster farms in their institutions. Others are in the localities. Almost every local government you visit now. Yes of course. The Governor on June inaugurated what we called Agro-Rangers. We have 300 of such across the State and so each agro ranger can be deployed to farm clusters so as to protect them from any security challenges. We also have anti-grazing and the Amotekun that has special unit for farmers' protection. In addition, we have started tractorisation program last year with 75/25 (Farmers, 75, government 25). But this year, we felt government must increase its own share, so we are doing 50/50 and the last time I checked, we have helped more than 500 farmers that have access to tractorisation and more than 1000 hectares of land have been plowed, harrowed and ridged with just half of the price.

With all these interventions, what are the prospects for food security in Ekiti State especially in the nearest future?

exercise, we were able to graduate 20 youths from the initial 47. We gave them their seed money and by today, they are standing on their own as poultry owners. They have birds they are raising and they are also helping to train our second batch. The second batch of 83 students started last two weeks and they got their first birds. We are increasing the birds from 10000 to 250000 at Erifun. Today, we are moving it down to other



Erifun is that we have accommodation in place. There are some dilapidated buildings built during the time of Awolowo which we have renovated and equipped with solar power, a well, DSTV and everything to make life comfortable. Now the other side of Erifun is where we have our horticulture that is; tomatoes, pepper, cucumber and the rest. For this category of trainees, we sent them to an organization called Soiless Farmlab to train them for three months on the best way of horticultural farming. So as we speak, we have sent no fewer than 200 youths from Ekiti to this institute in Abeokuta entirely sponsored by Mastercard. While they were there for 3 months, they paid them salaries as they were being trained. What next after their training? We have cleared 20 hectares for them at Erifun. Then there is a dam that has been there for years, we have desilted and piped the dam up to the field where they can operate for dry season farming. So our plan is to expand the place such that all the pepper consumed in Ado will be produced there. The last program I want to make mention is an aggressive move to bring back our youths into agriculture. The Governor launched it around June/July this year and it has employed more than 1000 youths scattered across Oke-Ako, Iyemero, Igede, Emure, Ikere, Aramoko. In

these seven centres, we have no less than 180 youths planting rice, maize, cassava, cowpeas and other crops. Apart from land preparation and supply of quality seedlings, government two weeks ago, donated a bus that would help to take them to the farm from home so that the cost of transportation can be reduced. Our plan is to expand the scope beyond the seven local governments to every local government in the state. Lastly, people say government has no business in doing business, but we say no because, if government don't have interest in doing business, then it can stimulate it, we can bring private investor and streamline the process to ensure that the private investor that would come will not be discouraged. So we have opened all the clusters to off-takers. Even we, as a state needs to be food secured so that when people produce, government buys it as the practice in the developed world. Government will now come in and buy off the proceeds at a particular price, then in the off-season when the price is high, government comes in too and that is what we are looking to do in the coming months. So we are working to get silos and warehouses where we can purchase as much as possible to keep them till during the off season to







hen it comes to the assessment of Biodun Abayomi Oyebanji, His Excellency, I give it to him. Ab-initio, I know for sure that he has what it takes to help people like us in Ekiti State and as such from the beginning, we gave it to him that this man would be of help.
